# Instructions

Memory Verse Lane was created to be a fun way to practice memory verses. Please feel free to use the verses included or your own verses with the game. I included blank cards for you to add your own verses.

**Assembly:** Print out the game board and the memory verse cards. You can easily make this game into a file folder game or a workbox activity.

**Dice:** You will need a regular dice to play. If you want to make the game longer you can make all of the odd numbers on the dice equal to 1 space and all of the even numbers on the dice equal to 2 spaces.

**Game Pieces:** You can use different colored paper clips or a variety of coins as your game pieces.

**Game Play:** Roll the dice, move your marker. Follow the instructions on the squares as you land on them. When it says to read a verse you draw a memory verse card. There are a few ways that you can approach this square, but it is best to decide before the game begins. Option 1: The person whose turn it is draws and reads the card. Option 2: Another player draws the card and reads only the scripture reference and the player has to quote the verse (or try to). Option 3: Another player draws the card and reads only the scripture and the player has to guess the reference or where it is found. When a card has been used it can go to the bottom of the pile face up.
