Many years ago I made a journal jar as a gift. On little pieces of paper I hand wrote different journal ideas. I have now created a journal jar for you. All you need to do is print out the journal prompts on paper, cut them out, fold them up, and put them into a jar. The jar can then be used by you and your family or given as a gift. I only ask that you do not resell any jars made with these prompts.

When you are making your journal jar (for yourself or someone else) you could print the slips on colored paper. You could also print the prompts on the plain white side of scrapbooking paper.

The journal prompts can be stored in a plain mason jar or a fancy photo box. They could be glued to colorful index cards and stored in a small index card box.

For a gift you could select your favorite prompts. Then you could print them out and glue them to colored card stock. Then you could tie them in a pretty ribbon as a gift.

For homeschooling mamas these prompts would be great to use as part of your regular creative writing program. You could direct the child in what you want from their writing, or you could allow them some room in how they interpret the prompts. I encourage you to sit down with your children and write as well.

Feel free to go through the prompts and discard any that you don't like. I have also added blank cards at the end of this package for you to create your own cards.

It is my hope that you (or whoever receives this Journal Jar) are encouraged to become more creative in your writing. If you are not currently writing regularly, I encourage you to do so.
